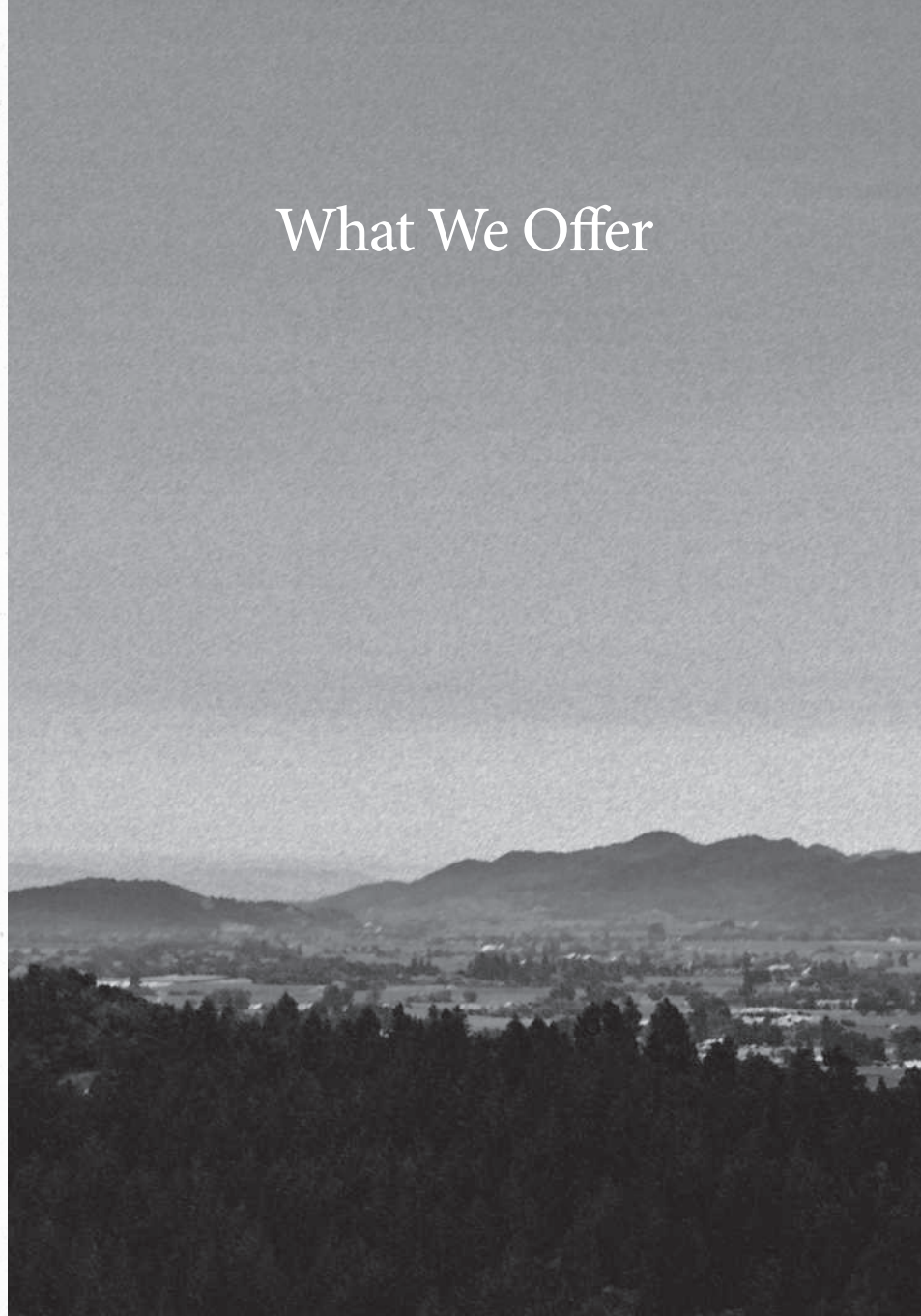
Objective
